The Worlds 3rd Producer of Gas

Iran is the world's 3rd gas producer and has production capacity of 550 million cubic meters of gas per day.

South Pars is the largest gas field of the world in the Persian Gulf and the territorial waters of Iran and Qatar and is communal between the two countries. The field occupies an area of about 9700 sq km 3700 sq km of which are located in the territorial waters of Iran. Iran's share of field reserves is about 500 trillion cubic feet in place and 360 trillion cubic feet to be exploited, which totally make about one-third of gas reserves in Iran and 5.5 percent of world gas reserves. There are 10 refinery and eight Petrochemical projects as well as three LNG units for deployment in the future will be designed. Daily 11 billion cubic feet of gas is produced in South Pars.



Petrochemical

- Iran is the second producer of petrochemical products in the Middle East
- Iran's petrochemical products make %25 of the Middle East market and about %2 of the world market
- Has over 10 companies active on petrochemical production
- Produces 70 types of petrochemical products such as methanol, ethylene, butane, ammonia, and urea
- Exported petrochemical products of about \$16 billion worth in 2012



Assaluyeh, Symbol of National Determination

Assaluyeh, located in southern Iran on the shore of the Persian Gulf, is best known as the site for the land based facilities of the huge PSEEZ (Pars Special Energy Economic Zone) project. It is the closest land point to the largest natural gas field in the world, the South Pars North Dome Gas-Condensate field and owns numerous large petrochemical and refining units.
